We are delighted that from September 2026 Rathmore Nursery will be expanding our Nursery provision. This means 52 funded full-time places and two full-time, teacher led classes operating from 8.45am – 1.15pm daily.

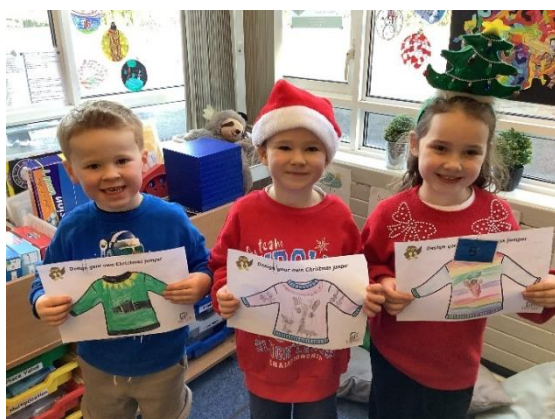
